- 1** Comments and proposals regarding:
- the size (limits) of the territory in question
 - assessment criteria
 - methodology
 - other aspects

- 2** Comments and proposals regarding the future EIA Report:
- content
 - scope (degree of completeness)
 - methodology
 - other aspects

- 3** Comments and proposals regarding the future SEA Report:
- content
 - scope (degree of completeness)
 - methodology
 - other aspects

- 4** After the preparation of the EIA Report, a 10 business day period is planned to allow the public to familiarise themselves with the report and to submit comments and proposals to the authors.

IMPORTANT!

At the end of the 10 business day period, a public meeting will be held to discuss proposals made by the public.

- 5** Proposals and comments regarding the preliminary “zones” specified in the concept of the Plan, but not individual land plots.

IMPORTANT!

Twenty days after the announcement is made, a public meeting will be held to discuss proposals made by the public.

- 6** General comments and proposals regarding the preparation of the SEA Report.

NOTE!

Proposals must be consistent with the document identifying the scope of SEA.

- 7** After the preparation of the SEA Report, a 20 business day period is planned to allow the public to familiarise themselves with the report and to submit comments and proposals to the authors.

IMPORTANT!

At the end of the 20 business day period, a public meeting will be held to discuss proposals made by the public. After the meeting no proposals regarding the SEA will be accepted.

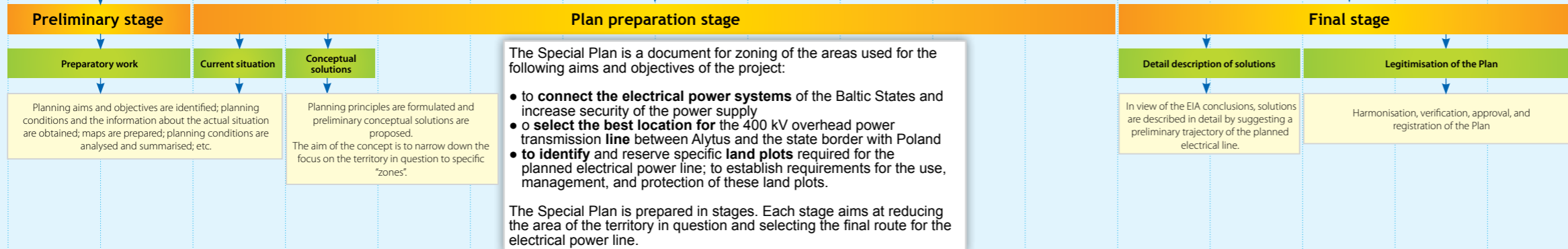
- 8** After the public meeting, the public may submit proposals and comments to the harmonising institutions.

- 9** Proposals and comments regarding the specific route of the electrical power line and specific land plots. Proposals and comments can be submitted 40 business days after the announcement is made. At the end of the term, the final meeting will be held where the author of the Plan will summarise and assess proposals received and, in case of the reasoned proposals, correct the Plan.

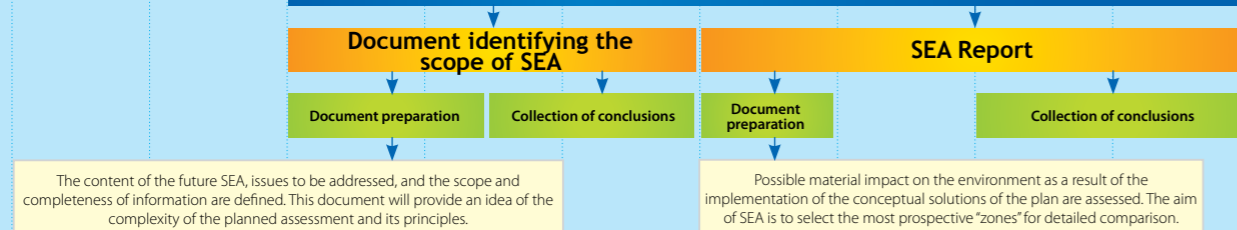
IMPORTANT!

After the meeting, no proposals regarding the Plan will be accepted.

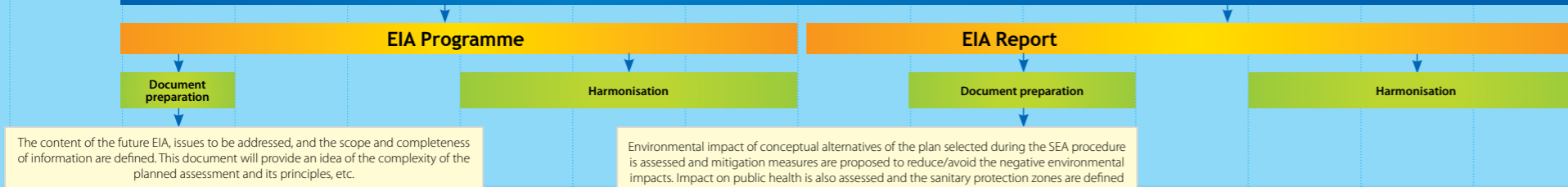
SPECIAL PLAN (PLAN)
